### <u>Administrator's Message</u>

Welcome to the 2019-2020 School Year! We are excited to get the school year going. We hold high expectations for our students and we believe that all of the students that attend Wesmor Public High School will achieve their individual goals. We look forward to our students coming to school each day, ready to learn, and with the same enthusiasm for learning as Wesmor staff has. This year staff and students will be focusing on the following school goals:

- > By June 2020, 100% of the students on the Wesmor graduation list, as of the end of Block 2, will have graduated.
- By the end of each Block in the 2019-20 school year, all students in grade 10-12 will have earned 2 credits OR will earn 50% of attempted course credits.
- By the end of each Block in the 2019-2020 school year, all Wesmor students will be reaching a level of proficiency or mastery or their individual benchmarks in each of their classes.

### Student-led Conferences

All caregivers and students are encouraged to attend conferences with their teachers. #### Front Door Locking Procedure

Wesmor Public High School will be locking the front doors during instruction time. The doors will be locked from 9:00 to 11:45 and at 12:35 to end of the day (the front doors will be open for breaks and lunchtime, when school staff members are supervising common school areas).

Please ensure that students have arrived at school prior to the start of morning or afternoon classes. Morning classes start at 8:55 and afternoon classes start at 12:30. If a student is late they will have to enter through the front doors by using the intercom system (located on the south side of the front entrance) and sign in at the office.

We welcome all visitors to stop in at the office during class hours so we can meet you and support our focus of providing uninterrupted learning time. If you have any questions please feel free call the school.

We will work hard to keep the communication open between parents, students and teachers, however, we honour learning time and try not to interrupt classes with pages and calls to the classrooms during class time. You are more than welcome to leave a message with the Secretaries in the office, and they will make sure that the student or teacher gets your message, or feel free to call during any of the breaks or over lunch.

### Automated Attendance Dialer System

Please ensure that a parent or guardian has called in when students are going to be away for the day or a period of time to excuse students for appointments, illnesses or other reasons. If not excused by the end of the day, you will receive a call from the automated service regarding your student's attendance.
